1. Preventing pollution reduces the regulatory burden on today's Marines, Sailors, and Civil servants. Conserving natural resources sustains tomorrow's use of our facilities, training areas, and surrounding coastal preserves. Therefore, my policy is that all personnel assigned to the 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU) will prevent pollution, spills, conserve natural and cultural resources, promote recycling, and comply with all environmental laws in order to sustain our capacity to train and deploy.

2. Personnel within the command shall familiarize themselves with the references and this policy. All echelons of leadership are responsible for ensuring awareness of this policy so that all personnel will be good stewards of the installation's facilities and training areas during daily operations. Whether in the workplace, in maintenance areas, on ship, or in the field the 15th MEU will find every opportunity to recycle.
